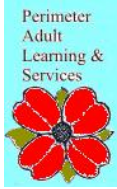

[A] 10:00 – 11:00 **THE BLACK EXPERIENCE 1900 – 1940** - Birdel Jackson will continue his focus on historical events affecting African-Americans in the United States, this time during the first half of the 20th century.

[B] 10:00 – 11:00 **ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY** - Representatives of the EPA will discuss how the agency regulates as well as monitors air pollution, waste-reduction, circular economy, waste utilization, water, and how sustainability helps business and individuals.

[C] 10:00 – 11:00 **INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION** - **Jack Carew** will discuss how for 1,000 years, centralized authority was aligned against the capability of the human brain. This absolutism peaked in 1492 and was replaced by self-determination. Independence to choose among an ever-expanding set of choices began in the 16th century with a wave of thinkers and doers, followed by other waves of people who helped to make life easy, happy and interesting up to the present.

[D] 10:00 – 3:00 **MAH JONGG** - Bring your own mah jongg card and come play for this weekly pickup game. This class is for intermediate to experienced players.

[E] 11:15 – 12:15 **ELLIS ISLAND & THE HISTORY OF IMMIGRATION** - **Dick Higgins** will present a history of immigration centering on Ellis Island in Upper New York Bay, which was the gateway to over 12 million immigrants to the U.S. and was the nation's immigration center from 1892 – 1954. He will trace this magnificent story accompanied by film footage and will outline America's immigration policies from the founding of the nation to the present day.

[F] 11:15 – 12:15 **SHAKESPEARE'S HENRY V** - **Michele Friedman** will discuss how the English of Shakespeare's day revered Henry V and considered him the last great Christian King of England, the King who had gained them an empire that subsequent kings lost. Shakespeare devoted three plays to analyzing him; Henry IV Part 1, Henry IV Part II and Henry V. We will discuss all three plays and watch videos of them to see what Shakespeare had to say about leadership, father-son relationships, and PR management (controlling the narrative), among other issues that the plays raise.

[G] 11:15 – 12:15 **HAMILTON vs MADISON** - **Linda Morrison** will discuss how James Madison and Alexander Hamilton were two of our most intellectual Founding Fathers, and among the most influential writers of the US Constitution, as well as co-authors of the Federalist Papers. Ten years later their views had diverged, and these changes led to the founding of our first two political parties. Their personal lives were also very different which will be discussed.
